EXHIBITOR REGULATIONS

1. Must have a Darke County Agricultural Ticket to enter, plus entry fees.
2. Pre-Entries Close at 12:00 P.M. Saturday, July 17, 2021. Entries can be made at Fair office or by mailing to Colette Warner-Lord.
3. Photo Copy of VACCINATION CERTIFICATE or FAVORABLE TITER TEST RESULTS must be turned in with entry form.
4. All dogs must be 4 months or older to be entered and attend fair.
5. Crates will be furnished or you may bring your own. X-pens can be used with a cover on it.
6. Entry Fee:
 - a. Pre-entry fee, due no later than July 17, 2021
 1. \$5.00 a dog per handler.
 2. \$10.00 multiple class (all 3 classes) with same dog and same handler.
 3. Second dog per class is \$3.00 with same handler.
 4. Team event is \$15.00. This is for all four members. Must turn in vaccination records for all dogs when making entry.

- b. Day of Show Fee:
 - 1. \$8.00 a dog per handler.
 - 2. \$20.00 multiple class (all 3 classes) with same dog and same handler.
 - 3. Team event is \$20.00. This for all four members. Must turn in vaccination records for all dogs when making entry
- 7. Female in season must leave the fairgrounds after showing.
- 8. All dogs shall be entered to be in the dog house.
- 9. All shots must be given by a licensed, veterinarian, to each and every canine or Favorable Titer Test Results. However, vaccinations may be given by an owner/breeder as long as proof to the vaccinations can be given in writing with labels from the bottles to the Dog Department Secretary.
- 10. Dogs must be vaccinated against distemper, parvovirus, and Adenovirus Type II (CAV)-2) and parainfluenza (CPI) within the last 12 months prior to the closing date of the exhibit.
- 11. All dogs must have a current rabies vaccination by a licensed, veterinarian.
- 12. Any dog having won best in show in the last (1) year will not be allowed to enter for competition in conformation. The dog however may be shown as exposition only.
- 13. The Open Conformation dog show shall be judged by a conformation judge or an experienced handler.
- 14. Altered dogs shall be accepted to show in conformation.

BARN RULES

- 15. Positively no owners or dogs shall be permitted to stay in the dog house after closing time.
- 16. All Dogs should enter Gate #5 on St. Rt. 121 South.
- 17. Any dog that is not under control at all times, will be dismissed.
- 18. All kennels will be securely fastened when dog is in crate.
- 19. Any animal showing visible signs of illness will be asked to be checked by a veterinarian or asked to leave.
- 20. All judge's decisions of show are final.
- 21. Grooming can be done in dog house but no fees or donations will be allowed.
- 22. Any mistreatment of any dog will not be tolerated.
- 23. Display tables are permitted and will be granted with advance notice and as space allows.

OPEN OBEDIENCE MATCH

- 1. Must have a Darke County Agricultural ticket to enter, plus entry fees.
- 2. Must provide vaccination certificate to be allowed to show in obedience match. All vaccinations must be in order as stated in exhibitor regulations.
- 3. Exhibitor Regulations.
 - a. All shots must be given by a licensed veterinarian to each and every canine OR a favorable titer test results may be provided.
 - i. Vaccinations may be given by an owner/breeder as long as proof of the vaccinations can be given in writing with labels to the Dog Department Secretary.
 - b. Proof of vaccinations, as well as a copy of current dog license, are due to the Dog Department Secretary by Saturday, July 17, 2021, and must accompany entry form.
 - i. Vaccinations required:
 - 1. Vaccination Certificate or Favorable Titer Test Results. Including Rabies.
 - c. All dogs must be at least 4 months old or older to be entered and attend fair.
- 4. Pre-Entries Close at 12:00 P.M. Saturday, July 17, 2021. Entries may be made at Fair Office or in the coliseum on the fairgrounds by the above date and time or by mailing to Colette Warner-Lord
- 5. Crates will be furnished or you may bring your own.
 - a. X-PENS with cover
- 6. Entry Fees:
 - a. \$3.00 for one dog in class.
 - b. \$2.00 per additional class with same dog.
 - c. \$5.00 for team class entry per dog. (4 people per team)
- 7. All dogs should enter Gate #5 on St. Rt. 121 South.
- 8. Any dog that is not under control at all times will be dismissed.
- 9. All kennels/crates will be securely fastened when dog is in the crate.

Special Awards for High in Match

Veteran — Trophy & \$10.00

- Dogs that are 8 years old or older may qualify for Veteran High In Match.
- Veterans may enter any regular class to be considered for this award.
- Award to be given to the veteran with the highest obedience score from any of the regular classes and will be awarded to one (1) handler and dog team.

Overall High in Match — Trophy & \$10.00

- Award to be given to exhibitor/dog team with the highest obedience score from any of the regular classes and will be awarded to one (1) handler and dog team.
- Veteran handler and dog teams, as well as, Jr. Fair handler and dog teams may qualify for this award.

PEE WEE SHOW

1. Open to children ages 4 thru 8 years of age.
2. Child must know the dog they are handling and dog must already be registered/approved to show at the Darke County Fair.
 - a. Can be a 4H Dog or a dog registered in an Open show.
3. Obedience and Showmanship classes will be offered.
 - a. Child may show in either Obedience or Showmanship but not both.

**Farm Machinery, Displays of All Kinds
and All Articles Not Otherwise Classified in List**

Exhibitors must furnish their own tents.

Manufacturers, Inventors and Dealers are cordially invited to display farm equipment used for cultivating the soil, producing crops or raising livestock that also meets the criteria for Agricultural Sales Tax exemption*. Exhibitors that display self propelled combines and choppers or farm tractors that have a horsepower rating of 80HP or higher will receive a \$50.00 per piece refund, not to exceed \$250.00.

Note: A minimum of 75% of the display must meet this criteria to qualify as an Agricultural Display.

*Agricultural Sales Tax exemption: This would include, but is not limited to: seeds, fertilizers, insecticides, pesticides, field tiles, tractors, plows, combines, and specially designed motor vehicles with PTO applicator units that travel from farm to farm to apply chemicals and fertilizers.
